My son, Alex, was born on January 17, 2003, and weighed 6 lbs 12 1/2 oz. Now, I am working, going to church every week, and helping with the youth group. I am also helping a young girl that is struggling just as I was. I want to thank Becky, Beth, and Carrie Anne for lots of love and giving me hope for the future.
